

HARVEST FIELD MINISTRIES HELPFUL DONATIONS LIST

A significant portion of your trip fees are used to purchase medicine and supplies for the clinic work, but it is very helpful when we can have some items donated.

Your team leader will likely let you know if there are specific items needed for your trip. Below are lists of general items we need for almost every trip. There are prescription medicines, over the counter medicines, and various supplies which would be helpful to have donated. Feel free to invite your family, friends, and co-workers to donate some of these items.

Topicals and over the counter meds

clotrimazole cream or miconazole cream. 7 day tube. no applicator needed.

neosporin/polysporin

hydrocortisone 1% cream tubes, 30 gram tubes

permetherin 5% cream, 30 gram tubes

aquaphor tubes, about 45-60 gram tubes

tylenol/APAP suspension 120 ml bottles

ibuprofen/motrin/advil suspension 120 ml bottles

benadryl/diphenhydramine 25 mg, 100 count bottles

TUMS/Ca Citrate, 100+ count bottles

peptobismol, boxes of 30 count

MVI adult, 100+ count bottles

prenatal vitamins, 100+ count bottles

peds MVI with iron, 100+ count bottles

Antibiotics (preferably 100-500 count bottles)

Zithromax, Diflucan, Amox, Cipro, Floaxcin, Rosephin, Batrim, Keflex, Flagyl

Med Supplies

chux pads/puppy pads

scissors - trauma , and fiskars

thermometers, especially temporal

curlex gauze

ace wraps

normal saline 10 ml flushes

IV catheters and tubing

Pregnancy tests

HIV tests

Automatic blood pressure cuffs

gauze of all sizes

hand sanitizer, 8 oz containers

Misc. & Admin Supplies

sharpie markers (black)

AA, AAA, 9V batteries

trash bags - 13 gallons and 30 gallons

cotton balls

clorox wipes

packing tape & masking tape

Baby formula (powdered only; no liquid!)

diapers, size 1 and 3

ziploc baggies, 1 quart size and 1 gallon size
